Red Flags of BPH

- Hypocontractility
 - Incomplete emptying
 - Post void residual > 100ml
- Overactivity
 - Frequency
 - Urgency
 - Nocturia > 1x
- Other
 - UT
 - Macrohaematuria

Investigations

- Urine analysis or MSU blood or infection
- UEC or renal function
- Renal ultrasound gives information on prostate size, sometimes shape and importantly chronic bladder damage (trabeculation and diverticulae), incomplete emptying and also kidney damage
- PSA

Erectile Dysfunction

In an Australian study measuring self-reported erectile dysfunction in 108,477 men aged 45 years or older, the overall prevalence of erectile dysfunction was 61% (25% with mild erectile dysfunction; 19% with moderate erectile dysfunction; 17% with complete erectile dysfunction) ¹.

BPH Relief. In Sight...

Urolift is a relatively new, minimally invasive technique designed to improve urinary symptoms caused by an enlarged prostate or BPH. Gold Coast urologist Dr Elmes, was one of the first surgeons in Queensland to perform it.

The procedure is carried out by inserting several small internal stitiches into the prostate, compressing the tissue outwards and thus widening the internal diameter of the urethra. It does not involve cutting or lasering of any of the prostate tissue and as such results in a far better side effect profile:

- ✓ No Erectile Dysfunction
- √ No stress urinary incontinence
- √ No retrograde (backwards) ejaculation




Figure 1: UroLift procedure

UroLift IPSS results

With the use of the IPSS score system we have monitored patient progress from pre-treatment to post operative stages of their Urolift procedure.


Average Age 67 yrs

<u>Pre-treatment</u> – 53 patients recorded with average IPSS score of 22

3 months post op - 53 patients recorded with a reduced average of 9

6 months post op - 38 patients recorded with an average of 6

1-year post op - 18 patients recorded (to date) with an average of 3
